# **Piglet**



### The head

- Cast on 6 stitches in PINK.
- Row 1; KFB 6 times, making 12 stitches.
- Row 2; purl
- Row 3; knit 1, make 1 stitch by picking up the loop between stitches, [knit 2, make 1 stitch by
  picking up the loop between stitches] and repeat until one stitch from the end of the row,
  knit 1 (making 18 stitches)
- Row 4; purl
- Row 5; knit 3, make 1 stitch by picking up the loop between stitches, knit 6, make 1 stitch by picking up the loop between stitches, knit 6, make 1 stitch by picking up the loop between stitches, knit 3 (making 21 stitches)
- Row 6; purl 7, knit 1, purl 5, knit 1, purl 7. The knit stitches mark the spots for the eyes.
- Row 7; knit
- Row 8; purl
- Row 9; knit
- Row 10; P3, P2TOG, P11, P2TOG, P3 (19 stitches)
- Row 11; knit
- Row 12; P2, P2TOG, P2, P2TOG, P3, P2TOG, P2, P2TOG, P2 (15 stitches)
- Row 13; K2, K2TOG, K1, K2TOG, K1, K2TOG, K1, K2TOG, K2 (11 stitches)
- Row 14; P2TOG, P1, P2TOG, P1, P2TOG, P1, P2TOG (7 stitches)
- B&T

#### The body

- Cast on 28 stitches in PINK
- Rows 1-2; rib {K1, P1]
- Rows 3-17; stocking stitch (starting and ending with a knit row)
- Row 18; P2TOG across all stitches (making 14 stitches)
- Row 19; K2TOG across all stitches (making 7 stitches)
- Row 20; P1, P2TOG across all stitches (making 4 stitches)
- B&T

### The snout

- Cast on 8 stitches in PINK
- Knit one row
- B&T. Turn into a flat circle and secure with a few stitches.

# The ears (make 2)

- Cast on 6 stitches in PINK
- Row 1; knit
- Row 2; slip 1, P2TOG, purl remaining stitches
- Row 3; slip 1, K2TOG, knit remaining stitches
- Rows 4-6; continue like this, alternating knit and purl rows, decreasing in each row, until you have only 2 stitches left
- P2TOG
- Cast off

### The tail

- Cast on 3 stitches
- Knit an i-cord that is long enough to make a pig tail curl in it (about 4 cm)
- cast off



### Making up

- Embroider the eyes in BLACK, on the marked spots
- Attach the snout to the face and embroider the nostrils
- Sew up the head, filling it as you proceed
- Thread the base of the ear and attach it to the head. This will make the ear curl a little. Do the same with the other ear
- Sew up the trunk
- Sew up the body and attach the head and tail
